

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS

Building Evacuation/ Fire Alarm

In the event of a fire, an alarm will sound followed by directions prompting a building evacuation to an Emergency Assembly Point (EAP).



If the fire alarm activates:

- If you have a disability and need assistance evacuating, call 911 and report your location.
- Feel the upper part of the doors – if it is hot do not open it. Open door slowly if it is not warm. Close doors/allow doors to close behind you.
- Follow the exit signs to the nearest stairwell and proceed to the ground floor. Do not use the elevators in an emergency.
- Once on the ground floor of your building, follow the exit signs to the nearest exit.
- If you notice damage to the building, stay away from that area.
- Do not touch electrical equipment that has become damaged or wet.
- Gather at the safest and closest [EAP](#) on campus.
- Once at the EAP, stay calm and wait for a Stanford official to notify you when it's safe to return to the building.

Medical Emergency

In the event of a medical emergency, immediately call Stanford University Emergency Services at 911. Follow the instructions provided.

Earthquake

In the event of an earthquake:

- Duck.
- Find safe cover and hold. Keep away from windows and shelving.
- Wait until the shaking stops.
- Once shaking has stopped, evacuate the building.
- Do not use elevators.
- Go to your nearest EAP.
- Buildings will be examined before re-entry.

Power Outages

Most power outages are resolved quickly. Wait for a situational update from Stanford University Emergency Services.
