In addition to her research and teaching, Miller is a regular health and science contributor to the Washington Post. She has two books about food, agriculture and health: The Jungle Effect, The Science and Wisdom of Traditional Diets and Farmacology, Total Health from the Soil Up. Farmacology appears in four languages and was the basis for the award-winning documentary In Search of Balance.
